Dear Parents and Carers,

You will have seen in the Headteacher's letter to you dated 20th April that we will be setting assessments over the next month to gather further evidence in order to determine your child's grades. These are not exams, nor designed to play the role of exams.

As outlined in the Headteacher's letter, the standard approach will usually involve a longer assessment at the end of the half-term, with a small number of shorter assessments over the next four weeks. This information has been communicated to pupils in today's assembly and in their lesson time this week or in their first lesson next week. Your child has already received a Personal Learning Checklist of the content of these assessments and these have not changed.

The following assessments will be running in the week commencing 26th April.

Physics	Mechanics and Working as a physicist
Chemistry	Atomic Structure and the periodic table + Chemical bonding and structure

Further Mathematics	Proof by induction Further complex numbers Matrices Vectors
English Literature	Crime - a statement on crime writing followed by a 'to what extent' question on 'When Will There Be Good News'
History	The First World War and its impact on British India, 1914–20
Politics	Knowledge Test - Comparative Politics USA
PE	Paper 2 - Memory Models - One Paper 2 - Commercialisation of Sport
