Dear Parents/ Carers,

Re: National Education Union Strike Action – Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May

The National Education Union (NEU) have confirmed that they will be taking strike action on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May in respect of the issues of pay and funding for schools.

A large number of teachers at the school are members of the NEU and I anticipate that there will be very few teachers available on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May to provide lessons for the students. I, therefore, regret to inform you that the school will not run on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May for most students in Years 7 to 10 and Year 12. We are making provision for those students whose parents are 'key workers' or who need to be in school for their health and welfare. The definition of 'key workers' is that which was used during the pandemic, being those who work in what are considered essential services. If you are the parent or carer of a student who will be attending school under one of the above criteria please can you notify the school by sending an e-mail to info@cfbs.islington.sch.uk.

Year 11 and Year 13 students will have a normal school day to support them in their final preparation for the exams.

The school will provide work for all students to complete through the Satchel One platform.

The school will have a hot meal available for students eligible for free school meals. If you wish for your child to have lunch at the school on the strike day, please send an email to info@cfbs.islington.sch.uk.

I am very sorry for the inconvenience that this strike action causes to parents and carers. As a school, we will be doing our utmost to make up the impact of the lost education.
