Are you in Year 12 and interested in architecture, design & the environment?

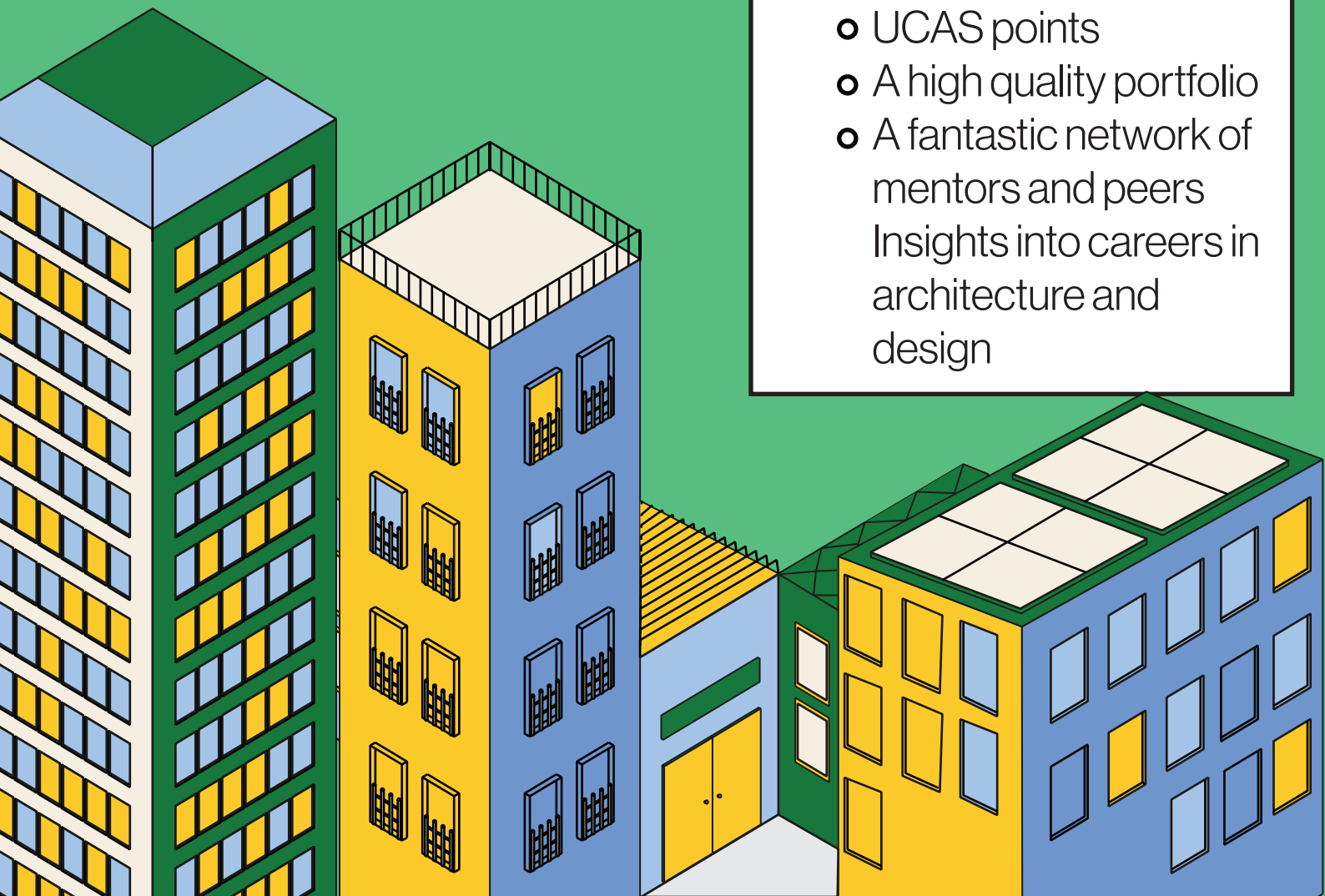
Concept
