### **Preparation for Assessment Point 1 exams and half-term provision**

The students will be sitting their Assessment Point 1 exams in the week after half-term. The students have been preparing for these through their lessons, homeworks and the small group catch-up sessions that some of the students have been asked to attend.

Over half-term, all subjects have set revision homeworks that all students should complete as part of their final preparations. You can support the students by identifying the days and time when they will complete this revision homework over the break. The revision homework anticipates a time commitment of three hours a day over the five days. All of the homeworks are posted on Satchel One.

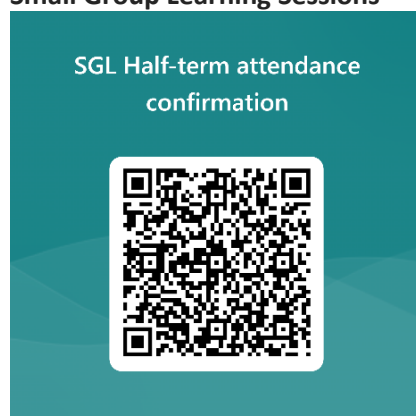
The students will be able to attend school for private study on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October and Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> October. These private study sessions will run from 9 a.m. to 10.30 a.m. and from 10.45 a.m. to 12.15 p.m., and are open to all.

In addition, some students have been invited to Small Group Learning sessions (SGLs). Students will be given a printed copy of their schedule tomorrow. The **first session** of each day will run from 9 a.m. to 10.30 a.m. and the **second session** of each day from 10.45 a.m. to 12.15 p.m.

The students **do not** need to wear uniform for the weekend and half-term sessions. The school will open 15 minutes before the sessions start and the sessions will start on time, with students **not able to be admitted to the sessions if they arrive late**.

Please can you confirm attendance to the sessions by Wednesday 4pm using the QR code or the link below. This will allow the school to re-allocate the place on the session to another student if attendance is not possible.
